Description of Composting Facility	
<p>The introduction of Animal By-Product Regulations had a major influence on the construction of the composting facility, which was one of the first in Ireland to receive Departmental Approval in October 2006. The process used is classified and acknowledged as an In-Vessel system using membrane covered, positively aerated and monitored static heaps for the intensive and curing phases and an aerated but uncovered maturation phase. The complete process lasts 10 weeks, during which time the material must meet standards laid down by Animal By-Product regulations, such as particle size and temperature & time parameters.</p> <p>Organic Waste currently being delivered to our site, or collected from clients, includes fish & shellfish waste, gelatine, various sludges, pre & post process food waste, kitchen/canteen waste and green/garden waste. From these traditional waste streams, we create value added products.</p> <p>Following numerous trials with various landscapers and extensive work carried out by German company Humus & Erden Kontor (leading specialists in the area of developing and marketing compost products), we now produce a range of top quality compost products and soil improvers which are ideal for landscape and golf course use.</p> <p>We started a commercial collection service of biodegradable kitchen/canteen waste in 2005, with the establishment of a bin system suitable for the Kitchens and Canteens of large institutions such as hospitals, colleges, hotels, restaurants, etc. Our current collection route services areas stretching from Letterkenny to Killybegs to Sligo. Plans are under way to expand this service in the coming months to meet increasing demand.</p> <p>We also accept a range of feedstock from wood pallets/demolition wood waste, forest waste and logs & stumps – from these waste streams we create a range of products such as wood chip & beddings for the agri & equestrian markets and wood chip fuels. We also</p>	

buy in raw bark from the sawmills to produce various grades of garden mulches.
